**Want to make digital music files sound great?

Most digital music sounds etched and hard. Mp3 files can be almost unlistenable. However, if you take these files, transfer them digitally to an outboard digital to analog converter, run that signal through a "tube" preamp and power it with a high-current amplifier, the results are amazing! This is what you get with a Decco a simple one cable hook-up.

The Decco is a 50 watt per channel, hybrid tube integrated amplifier. HUH? This means all music first travels through a tube section which smoothes the sound significantly before it's then sent to the amplifier section. It has an onboard digital to analog converter that sonically improves digital sources. iTunes or Windows Media, Squeezebox, Apple TV, Wadia digital iTransport, Airport, Sonos, XM or Sirius tuners have never sounded better than through the Decco D/A converter. The Decco has a USB input for your computer, a coax and optical input for any of the digital devices listed above. It also has two analog inputs for docking stations, CD players, tape decks or phono preamp.

If you're a headphone lover, the Decco has a superb headphone section that mutes the speakers when headphones are plugged in.

If you want to add a subwoofer or outboard amplifier, the Decco features a variable preamp-output.

If it's digital, the Decco makes it sound great!

Now all the time, effort and money you've spent ripping CDs and downloading music is rewarded with truly incredible sound. Although our company is a big believer in lossless encoding, even compressed MP3 files sound almost indistinguishable from the original CD when played through the Decco.

If you spend a significant amount of time in front of your computer listening to small plastic speakers, we can dramatically improve the experience. Just add a Decco and a good pair of good mini-monitors and the music files on your hard drive are transformed to deliver better bandwidth and depth than you ever dreamed possible. Since the Decco was designed with era speakers, we recommend trying the era **D4's** or **D5's**. Be on the lookout for Peachtree Audio speaker to go with the Decco coming soon.

While we really like lossless encoding, the first thing you'll notice is how well mp3 recordings perform through the Decco. Internet radio content is almost limitless and played through the Decco sounds full and dynamic. Best of all, most of the content is free!

When you feel the urge to listen, but the environment won't allow, just plug in a set of headphones and the speakers automatically mute while your listening thru a tube preamp section.

The iPod has become a universal audio source for many home music systems, but if you're listening to it through a normal docking station, its sound quality is severely limited by the iPod and dock's analog outputs. The good news is that if the music is on your iPod, it's also on your computer, a much better device for delivering high resolution audio.

With the decco you can unleash the potential of your digital music because for the first time, you can take a pure digital signal from iTunes, Windows Media, Front Row or any other music management system on your computer before it goes through the sound card. Just hook up a 2.0 USB cable between your computer and the Decco and no other sound card is required.

The decco includes a high-quality D/A converter to accept the digital signal directly from your computer. The signal is then routed thru a tube preamp, smoothing out harsh digital artifacts and then passing thru a high current amplifier allowing you to enjoy this medium as a true high-end music source. Now all of the time, effort and money you've spent ripping CDs and downloading music is rewarded with truly incredible sound.

Decco with Sonos ZP80



Sonos ZP80:

Sonos is a wireless (or wired), multi-room digital music system that lets you play all your favorite music all over your house—and control it all from the palm of your hand. We were so impressed by the Sonos, we made a slot in the back of the Decco for a ZP80... The ZP 80 has no power of its own, however it does have a coax digital out. When you use the digital out into the Decco, the Sonos system has the ability to sound like a high-end CD player.



1. Take "coax digital" out of the ZP 80 into coax digital input on Decco
2. Switch to coax input
3. If you're using the volume control on the Sonos handset, turn the Decco volume to 10:00 position

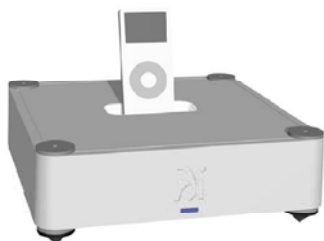
The Duet gives you a multi-room controller with 2.4-inch color display makes it easy to browse, select, and play songs from your personal collection, Internet radio — even online music services.

The 170i is a perfect addition to the Decco. With its true digital output hooked up through a Decco, the iPod becomes a true high-end music server for the first time ever.

The 170i is one of the first such products to access video content stored on currently available iPods. Similar to the audio section, the video signal is made available via high performance component outputs that provide up to DVD-quality video.

The iTransport measures 2” x 8” x 8” (H/W/D), making it an easy fit on top of the Decco. Wadia incorporates a bit-perfect S/PDIF digital audio output that plugs directly into the Decco dac. iPod players are charged while in the dock, and can be operated via Apple’s standard IR remote control.
